## **Acclaimed Independent Comedy Film *All Along* Showing in 93 US Theatres from March 9-14**

*Independent Film Festival will screen All Along nine times in each theatre*

**WILMINGTON, DELAWARE – JANUARY 21, 2009** – The award-winning, independent comedy film *All Along* will be shown during the Independent Film Series being presented by Carmike Cinemas from March 9-14. *All Along* will be shown in 93 theatres located in 31 states during the festival.

Directed by Robert Angelo Masciantonio (*Cold Hearts*), *All Along* features Bill Page as a married family man turning 40 who needs help understanding his consuming “what if” fantasies, as he colorfully imagines what might have happened if his life had taken different turns. He seeks the insights of a psychologist, played by actress Krista Allen (*Unscripted, Liar Liar, Confessions of a Dangerous Mind, What About Brian*), who may hold the key to the answers he seeks in fantasy as well as in reality.

Page is also the film’s co-writer and executive producer. *All Along* also features Charlie McDermott (*The Village, Frozen River*) and cult film fave Erin “Misty Mundae” Brown. Shot entirely in Delaware, *All Along* has been screened at 17 US film festivals and won 8 awards, including the Eagle Award for “Best Comedy” at the Schweitzer Lakedance International Film Festival and the “Best in Show” Award from the Accolade Film Awards. The 75-minute film’s format is HD Digital Video.

*All Along* will be screened nine times at each participating theatre from March 9 through March 14. Bill Page is scheduled to appear at several of the upcoming Independent Film Series screenings, including Dover, Delaware; Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania; and Richmond, Virginia, and will be promoting the film through media appearances.
